

GLEN ELLYN MOSQUITO AGATEMENT DISTRICT  
MINUTES OF MEETING-MAY 21, 2014

The Meeting was called to Order by President Ryan at 6:00 P.M.. Present were Trustees Ryan, Clark and Morrissy. Also present were Thomas Eckhardt, District Counsel, and Jack Thennisch representing Clarke.

For the first time the Meeting was held in Room 303 at the Glen Ellyn Village Hall after losing space at the 493 Duane Building where meetings were held since 1972.

On Motion by Trustee Morrissy and seconded by Trustee Ryan, the Minutes of the April 16, 2014 Meeting were unanimously approved.

Under Old Business, Eckhardt reported that he responded to the State's Attorney's Office regarding the 2002 and 2003 Tax Levy Complaints and the District's offer of settlement.

Also, under Old Business, Eckhardt received a Letter of Resignation from Trustee Jamrok and gave copies of it to each Trustee.

As to the Ledger, Eckhardt reported that it had a balance of \$38,307.72 before May payments to Clarke in the amount of \$16,152.68, to Eckhardt in the amount of \$650.00 and to Verizon for \$48.56. He further reported that the District received \$457.34 in Replacement Taxes.

Mr. Thennisch then reviewed Clarke's May report. Larval site inspections had begun. The owners of the property on Milton Avenue on which the District has maintained one of its light traps, have sold the property. A new site will need to be found, perhaps more northerly in the District. As to the outlook for the mosquito season, soil moisture levels are back to normal and with spring rains, the flood water mosquito levels should also increase to normal levels.

The meeting was then adjourned at 6:00 P.M..
